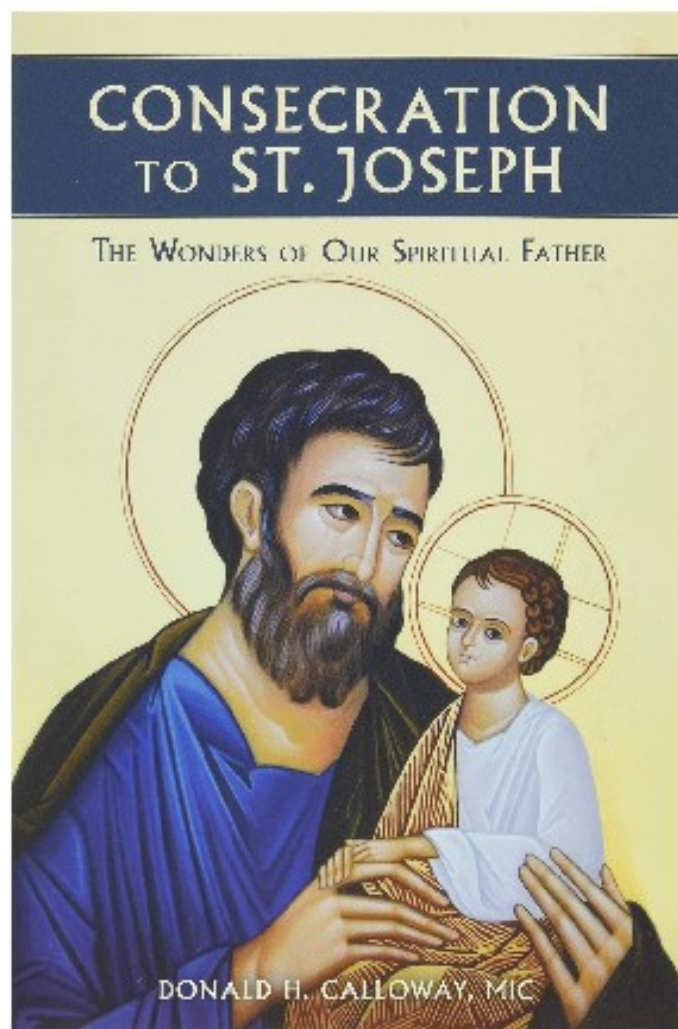
### Welcome to Consecration to St. Joseph!
