Jesus summoned the Twelve and began to send them out two by two and gave them authority over unclean spirits. He instructed them to take nothing for the journey but a walking stick— no food, no sack, no money in their belts.” Mark 6:7

Summer is a time of travel. It seems strange to say that since we've been very cautious in doing so this past year. But so many are now taking to the skies, highways and waterways for travel experiences. In our modern world, we have the capacity to be very mobile, whether for vacation or work. If we look at our religion, Christianity is a religion on the go as well. It is, you can say, a walking religion. We're not a sitting religion. We are often described as pilgrims or sojourners.
