A Written Tour by Silvia Alderman The Face of Jesus



Continuing with our in-depth look at the altarpiece, we pause for some background about Jesus' face. The large crucifix that adorned our back wall so many years was not the original for our church. Recall that at one time a choir loft took up a sizable portion of the upper wall, so a smaller crucifix was displayed in the lower portion of the wall. When the choir loft was covered over, we changed crucifixes and a larger one was installed.

We had it for many years and was beloved by the parish. In order to facilitate a sentimental transition, we asked Granda to please give to the face of our new Jesus the same features as our old Jesus. That way, we could feel like we still had a part of our old crucifix with us in the sanctuary. Trying to put a very contemporary, modernist face on a Baroque statue was quite a challenge. However, focusing on the nose, the eyebrows and the beard made it possible. The sculptor did a lovely job of matching. Of course, our new Jesus is colorized but the face and hair are pretty close.

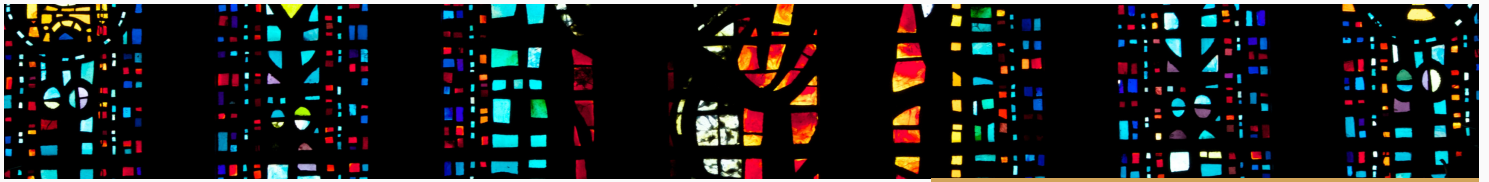

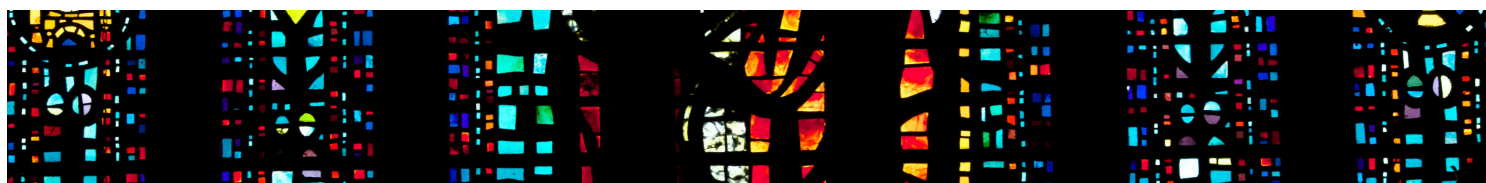
