Faith Formation is undergoing some changes. The Bishop has announced that our Diocese is going to Restored Order and wants more Family based Catechesis to happen.

What does that mean for St. Thomas More?

2025-2026

- Children in grades 6 and up will prepare for the sacrament of Confirmation in class Sundays 8:30 am 9:45 am.
- Children in grades 3-5 will be in class together Sundays 8:30 am 9:45 am.
- Children in grades 1-2 will be in class together Sundays 8:30 am 9:45 am.
- Children in 2nd grade will receive Communion and Reconciliation Preparation sessions with parents.
- Four Family of Faith programs will be offered on Sunday Afternoons. Childcare will be available for children 3 and under. Registration will take place for each event so that the proper number of supplies can be purchased etc.
- A Family Penance service will be held once a year on a Saturday morning.

2026-2027

- Children in grades 3 and up will prepare for the sacrament of Confirmation
- Children in grades 1-2 will be in class together.
- Children in 2nd grade will receive Communion and Reconciliation Preparation sessions with parents.
- Four or more Family of Faith programs will be offered.
- A Family Penance service will be held.

2027-2028

- Children in grades 1-2 will be in class together.
- Children in 2nd grade will receive Communion and Reconciliation and Confirmation Preparation sessions with parents.
- Four or more Family of Faith programs will be offered.
- A Family Penance service will be held.




Preschool is too early for a rigid and strict academic focus (kids' brains aren't ready yet!) much, when kids are playing hard, they are hard at work.
