Welcome our new Finance Director!

Last Tuesday, St. John's hired a new Finance Director, Ralph Preish, who previously served for over 10 years as CFO at Huther Doyle Memorial Institute. Our prior Finance Director served six local entities besides St. John's, he also served St. Mark's, St. Leo's, St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, Nativity, and the Newman Center at SUNY Brockport. We also had a shared Bookkeeper on our staff. We worked under this "sharedservices" model for a year, and although successful in many parishes around the Diocese, it was not sufficient for our needs. This is why I made the decision to replace both shared positions with a single Finance Director who serves us exclusively here at St. John's.

A full-time financial staff member will be an enormous help in preparing a complete account of the capital campaign. Collections and new capital projects proceed apace, and I have the greatest confidence in the members of our Buildings and Grounds committee, but I feel that it is important to have a report that captures exactly how much money has been collected and spent thus far. Once our new Finance Director is able to familiarize himself with the history of the capital campaign and all projects past, present, and future so as to generate a report, I will share it with the parish at large. For now, let me give you the "20,000 foot" view: Things are going well!

This week, the Buildings and Grounds committee will discuss numerous projects either proposed or presently in the works, including: a modification to the curbside handicap cut-out to allow easier access for wheelchairs; paving of the main parking lot; snow-diverting modifications to the west entrance of church; replacement of energy-inefficient original windows in Martha House and rectory; completion of the steeple work; installing an automated timer mechanism for the thermostat in church (a brief personal aside: I, in my vestments, am very glad to have the air conditioning turned on for the summer!!!); the installation of a hearing loop in church; and several others projects.

The Finance Director has, of course, many ordinary duties besides aiding the capital campaign. The job description that was posted during our search for a new Finance Director listed (I'm not making up this number!) 42 distinct "core functions" including areas such as budget. accounts payable, banking, payroll, etc. I have been impressed with Mr. Preish's initiative, even in the first few days, in identifying items that could be potential cost-savers as we budget for next year.

Many of you have no doubt noticed that the collection-vs-budget numbers printed weekly in this bulletin are not in parity. I think it is important to have a balanced budget, rather than to plan to 'make up the difference' by paying for current-year expenses out of savings. This past year has been a difficult one financially given the lack of "rent money" following the closure of the Religious Shop. Although the Divine Mercy Religious Shop became our "tenant" last December (and, thank God for the wonderful work they do!), we agreed to charge them a nominal rent of \$1 while they established themselves. On July 1, we will begin collecting rent equivalent to the cost of maintaining the portion of the school building occupied by the shop (totaling some \$9,000/year). putting us on a much better financial footing.

item from a recent Social Ministry Committee meeting. Father Paul G. Wohlrab left to St. John's in his estate a sum of money to help children attend our parish school. I was asked what we should do with the remaining funds. We had a great conversation about how to honor Fr. Wohlrab's wishes, and I proposed using this money for the cause that I believe will have the greatest impact on the religious education of our children: supporting further development of our catechists.

One such area of development about which I am thrilled beyond my ability to put into words is that we are going to introduce Catechesis of the Good Shepherd to our parish this Fall! CGS applies the teachings of Dr. Maria Montessori to imparting the faith, helping children ages 3 to 6 fall in love with Jesus through hands-on, experiential learning. Registered students will be able to spend two hours each Sunday in the Atrium, a designated learning space in the St. John's school building. To be able to offer this amazing program, staff member Julie Bailey and parishioner Kate Dominguez will attend two week-long intensive training sessions in order to be certified as lead catechists.

The opportunity to provide the \$500 tuition for this 80 hour summer training is just one example of how the generosity of the late Father Wohlrab can continue to provide for the religious education of our youngest parishioners. In the aforementioned meeting, several members of the Social Ministry Committee expressed a desire to honor Father Wohlrab by contributing to this fund. This month would mark Father's 103rd birthday and 77th anniversary of ordination. If you would like to honor Father Wohlrab's legacy by supporting the continuing education and development of those who help pass on the Catholic faith to our children, keep your eyes peeled later this month for a special

collection envelope for the Father Paul Wohlrab Fund!
