# **August 2, 2020 Eighteenth Sunday In Ordinary Time**

# Why Masks?

Some of you have asked why I take the time each week to make an announcement to remind everyone about the Bishop's guidelines concerning the necessity of wearing masks and the need to observe six feet of distance between yourself and each person not in your household. As perhaps you well know even from arguments within your own families, mask-wearing has become a "political" issue that divides people. So why weigh in on something that is not a matter of faith?

The short answer is: I am being obedient to my Bishop. One of the realizations that led to my becoming Catholic was that the Church in the first century after the Resurrection already possessed the hierarchical structure she still has. Every major city had a bishop that oversaw a vast swath of territory. St. Ignatius of Antioch, the "bishop of Syria" (*Epistle to the* Romans, 2) who was martyred around the year A.D.108, wrote seven letters of which we still have copies today. Among other things, he says:

- "Subject vourselves to the bishop as to Jesus Christ [...]. It is therefore necessary that, as you indeed do, so without the bishop you should do nothing" (*Epistle to the Traillians*, 2)
- "See that you all follow the bishop, even as Jesus Christ does the Father, and the presbytery as you would the apostles; and reverence the deacons, as being the institution of God." (Epistle to the Smyrneans, 8)
- "Wherever the bishop shall appear, the whole congregation is to be present; just as, wherever Jesus Christ is, there is the Catholic Church." (Epistle to the Smyrneans, 8)
- "He who does anything without the bishop's knowledge worships the **devil**." (Epistle to the Smyrneans, 9)

I have no great interest in the medical sciences, and no strong opinions on whether one course of action is or is not effective in reducing the rate of transmission of a virus. But what I do have a great interest in, is growing in holiness. One of the best ways to become humble and destroy one's pride is to be obedient to the will of another. And this is especially true of obedience to one possessing legitimate authority: how much more those bishops who derive their authority from being numbered among the successors of the Apostles in union with the successor of St. Peter!

This is why I ask everyone coming to church to wear a mask. The bishop has asked us to do this. It is right that, in society, there be a vigorous and continual debate about how best to meet the difficult circumstances we face in the world—and I invite you to engage in that debate at the proper place and time! But in the Church, we have the much simpler task of practicing obedience. Unless we be asked to do something that is actually contrary to the Catholic faith, obedience will get us to Heaven.

# Reminders from our Bishop

- In accord with current policy of the State of New York, the faithful (over two [2] years old) must wear cloth face coverings when in public, including when they come to church.
- Attendees should sanitize their hands at the entrance of the church via sanitizer stations. (We have hand sanitizer located at both entrances).
