Pastor's Quarantine

I had expected to announce in this bulletin article that I would be imminently departing for my annual retreat: a week each year in which I spend more time in prayer and reading, often at a monastery or some other quiet place. But at 12:17am on Thursday, I received a phone call informing me that a woman for whom I had celebrated the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick at 2:30pm on Wednesday had tested positive for Covid -19, meaning that my retreat will be two weeks in length, a 14day quarantine!

In obedience to the bishop's directives (not to mention the medical advice we've all been hearing in these last months), I had been wearing a mask as well as a hospital gown during my visit, and used hand sanitizer immediately after leaving the room. That, plus my age and general good health, puts me in a very low-risk category. Nonetheless, into quarantine I go! You will all be in my daily prayers, especially during Mass. If you should happen to find yourself walking down Martha Street early on some morning during my "retreat", and your eye is caught by candles glowing through the window that peers into the rectory oratory, you might catch a glimpse of me offering the Holy Sacrifice.

My thanks go out to all who made kind offers of assistance. even in just the first hours after I received this news. In particular, I want to thank Deacon Craig Stratton and Deacon David Kepler for taking on some of my scheduled baptisms, as well as Exposition & Benediction this coming Tuesday. And, although the details were not finalized by the time of publication, please do take a moment to thank (and pray for) the priests that you see at Masses here on the weekends—I dare say they have been inconvenienced more than I have!
