

Poor Box Collections for March will go to the **Andrews Center for Children.** Here Sisters of Mercy provide care for children who cannot be placed in foster care due to their multiple needs. These children, ranging from infants to 12 yrs, suffer from physical and emotional disabilities such as Down's, an inability to see, walk, or speak and various neurological disorders. At Andrews Center, the Sisters provide a warm and loving home life, as well as professional care for the child's physical and emotional needs.

Seek Ecological Conversion This Lent: Pope Francis defines ecological conversion as occurring when "the effects of our encounter with Jesus Christ become evident in our relationship with the world around us...We come to realize that a healthy relationship with creation is one dimension of overall personal conversion, which entails the recognition of our errors, sins, faults, and failures, and leads to heartfelt repentance and desire to change."

A Prayer for Lent: Creator God, you call us to repentance and self-denial. While we can choose our penances, so many of our brothers and sisters have not the basic needs of life. Teach us humility in our works of penance, so that our fast may be a victory over our own egotism and self-indulgence. Move us to step forward to choose life and protect and restore creation, reject war, promote equity and respect, be community and do justice so that we and our children may live. Every Friday beginning Friday, March 18th there will an open AA meeting here at St. John's in the Parish Center (chapel) at 5:30pm.


