



STORYTIME STEM SAINT TRAINING

The stories of the saints inspire us to grow in virtue! This All Saints Day, try picking a saint as a family to learn about and emulate. Can each member of the family find one way to mimic this saint's charism this month, by prayer, fasting, or acts of charity?

(e.g. Live like St. Dominic with a daily rosary, or like St. Francis by giving alms or volunteering.)

TIPS FOR PARENTS
