

Grade 6 Supply List

Dear 6th Grade Families,

Following is a list of school supplies which your child will need to begin the school year. Students are responsible for their own supplies, which may need to be replenished during the school year. Additional supplies may be required during the school year. It is the parent's responsibility to replace any lost or broken materials. Please label all supplies with the student's name and grade.

A medium sized backpack with straps that go over both shoulders- no shoulder bags please.
A **soft** lunch box

Headphones or earbuds in a ziplock bag labeled with the student's name (these will remain in class unless needed for another teacher)

8 Marble notebooks

1 pk construction paper (loose not bound) ***BOYS ONLY***

1 pk white envelopes ***GIRLS ONLY***

1 pk wide ruled loose leaf paper (not college ruled)

1 pk of white computer paper

1 pk. 8 ½ x 11 sheet protectors (no more than 25)

8 - 2 pocket folders (vinyl only- not paper)

1 - 2 pocket portfolio folder that has prongs to hold loose leaf and/or sheet protector, to be used as a writing folder **-insert sheet protectors on prongs in the folder**

A soft pencil case with a zipper which is to hold:

4 sharpened #2 pencils

3 erasable blue or black pens (Pilot FriXion erasable/retractable work well)

1 small covered pencil sharpener

1 thin yellow highlighter

Thin dry erase markers (1 blue, 1 black, 1 red)

1 pk 1" x 3" post-its to use as page markers

A **small** plastic art box (Sterilite 8 ⅝" x 5 ¾" x 2 ½ ") which is to hold :

1 pk. colored pencils (12 or 24)

1 pk. 10 Crayola broad line washable markers Classic Colors

1 box of crayons (no more than 24- no scented or glitter)

2 glue sticks

1 pair blunt safety scissors

1 small Elmer's liquid glue

Classroom supplies:

4 boxes of plain tissues (no aloe or lotion please)

2 pk. baby wipes

2 rolls of paper towels

Boys: 1 box of sandwich sized Ziploc bags

Girls: 1 box of gallon sized Ziploc bags
