



In honor of Mother's Day, our Sacred Heart Prepares group is sponsoring a "stuff the crib" donation drive for the Pullman Head Start program.

The drive starts April 11, and goes until May 9. **Requested items (new or gently used) are:** small soft dolls, teething toys/rings (Chewy Tubes especially), rattles, connecting rings, soft blocks, cloth books/indestructible books, small balls, simple shape sorter, simple ring stack, small set stacking cups or stacking boxes, stacking blocks (not interlinking like Mega Blocks) wood or plastic only, simple musical instruments, push/pull toys – cars (size of adult hand), animals on a short string, trains (no small parts), play mat/play blanket, sleep sacks, diapers – sizes newborn, one, two and three, burp rags, nursing covers, bottles/nipples, welcome baby bags – little soap, shampoo, lotion, wash cloths, baby nail clippers, etc. **Please bring your donations to the changing table in the Church entryway or contact Erin Phillips for a porch pickup at ekm08@vt.edu or 757-639-5960**


