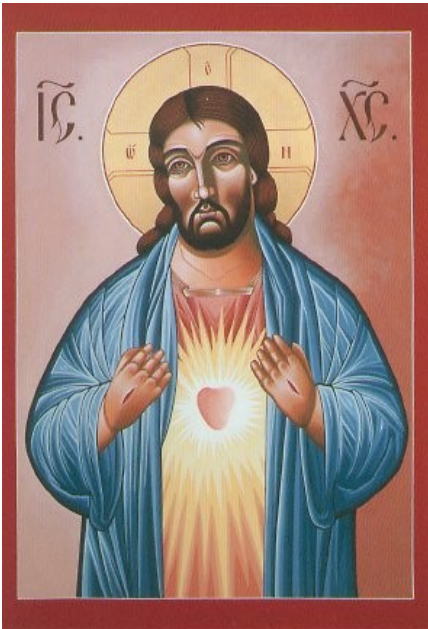

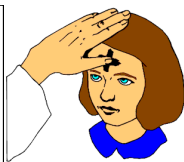

We invite all adults to join a study of the **Sunday Lenten Gospels**, Sundays, February 26 through March 26. A favorite Lenten tradition at Sacred Heart is **Prayer, Bread & Soup**. Each Wednesday, beginning March 1, we invite everyone to pray the Stations of the Cross in the church at 6 pm. Following the prayer, come to the social hall for a simple meal of soup and bread. Five different ministries from our parish will host and provide the soup supper. Donations for a charity will be accepted.

Lent is the 40 days of penance in preparation for Easter. During this season we pay attention to prayer, fasting, and giving – of our time, talent, and treasure. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting (ages 18 – 59) and abstinence from meat (age 14 & older) for Catholics. Also, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat (age 14 & older). When fasting, a person may eat one full meal, and two smaller meals that together do not equal a full meal, and not eat between meals. Serious circumstances (sickness, dietary needs, social obligation) excuse from fasting & abstinence, but not from other forms of penance.

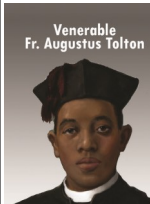
Please come down to the social hall after the 8:30 or 11 am Mass for **coffee or juice and doughnuts**. Hosting doughnuts is fun and easy to do.
