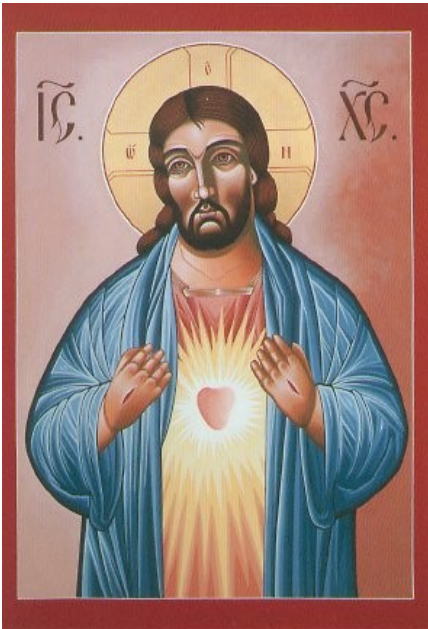

Please place items in the basket at the church entrance.

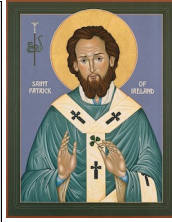
Lenten Bible Study
