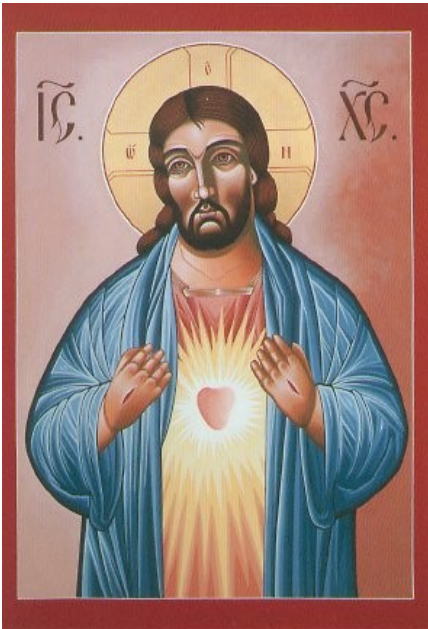

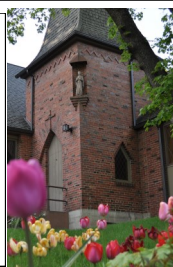

March 18/19: Shampoo/conditioner; soap; deodorant; toothpaste & tooth brushes. feminine supplies; laundry detergent; dish soap.

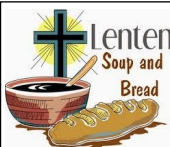
March 25/26: Ramen noodles (box or cup); granola bars; nuts; dried fruit, cup of soup; cookies; crackers; other snack food.
