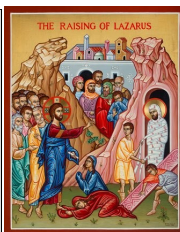
At the 8:30 and 11 am Sunday Masses we have a radio broadcast to the parking lot (87.9 FM) and communion.

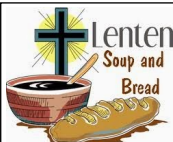
