

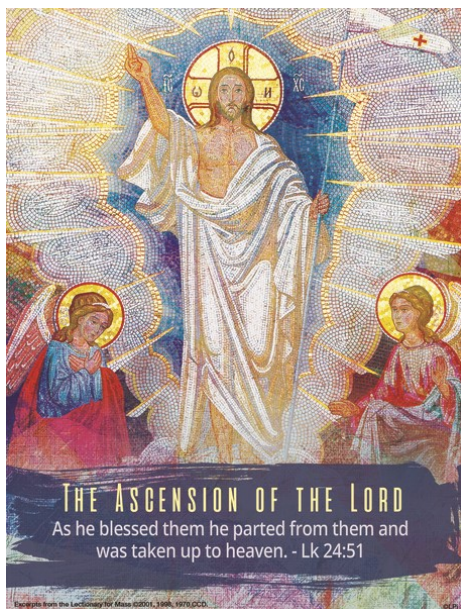

These works of art are made from the trimmings of the holy land olive tree. Trimming is an essential process for the health and growth of the trees. Absolutely no trees are damaged. The Olive wood has a unique beauty and quality not found in any other tree. The gradations, ripples and differentiations of color lines are a result of oil in the wood fibers. It needs very little care.
