

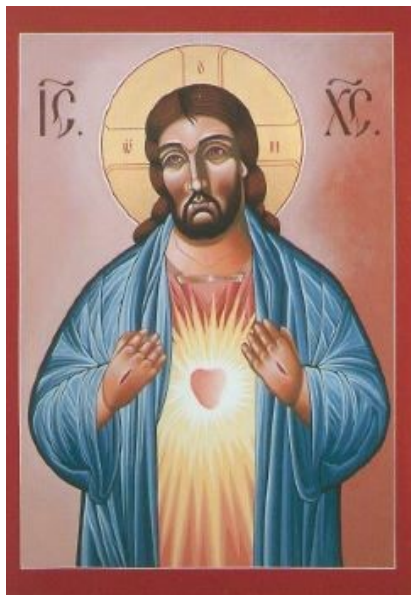

Parish information: There is a Family Room (an option for families with babies and restless preschoolers) up at the front of the church to the right of the altar.

The Family Room is also convenient for those who need to use *the accessible church entrance* which is behind the altar. This entrance is reached by turning right off Maple St. into the alley behind the church.

There is a bathroom on the main floor of the church in the Holy Family classroom behind the Family Room.

Faith Formation classrooms and the nursery (for children under 5 during Sunday Masses) are downstairs.

Diaper changing stations are in the upstairs bathroom and men and women's bathrooms (downstairs).

There is a parish library and bulletin board past the downstairs bathrooms, then the social hall at the far end.

The Parish Office (Fr. Steve, office manager, & bulletin editor) is in the old house next to the social hall.

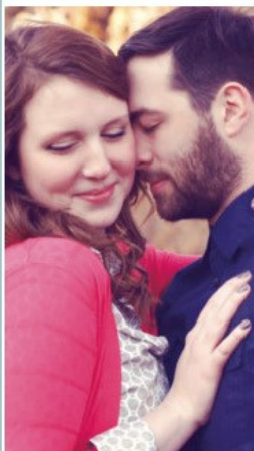
