

# Children's Faith Formation

It's time to register your children for Faith Formation Classes, which start Sept 17. For youth age 3 through high school. They help your child learn about the Cetholic foith. There is a registration table.

#### **Sacrament Prep:**

Baptism. Reconciliation. Confirmation. Eucharist.

Preparation for families of children receiving any of these sacraments begins with a parent meeting October 1 (9:45-10:45). Sacrament prep is open to children age 7 and up. Preparation consists of at-home family instruction and monthly parent support meetings.

The Diocese of Spokane is a restored order diocese, so children preparing for their first communion will also prepare to receive confirmation. If your child has received first communion but is not yet confirmed, please plan to attend these classes. We will discuss why this is at our first parent meeting. Register for sacrament prep as part of faith formation registration using the QR code above.

#### Cathecists needed! Do you enjoy children?

Would you like to help them grow in their faith? Consider becoming a catechist! Working in pairs from a provided curriculum makes this role easy. You don't need to be an expert in Catholicism.
