

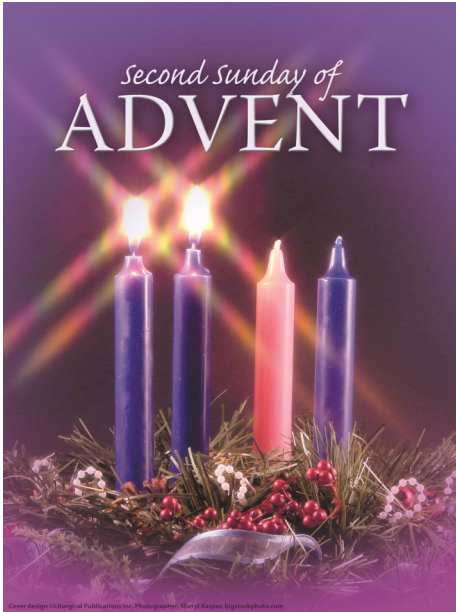

Sacred Heart Parish exceeded our \$65,809 goal. *A big thank you* to everyone who pledged!

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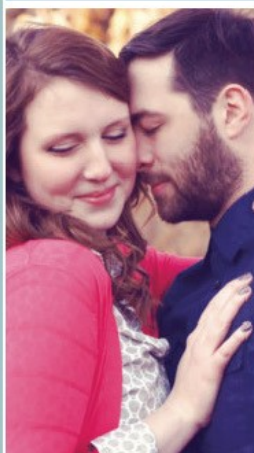
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
