

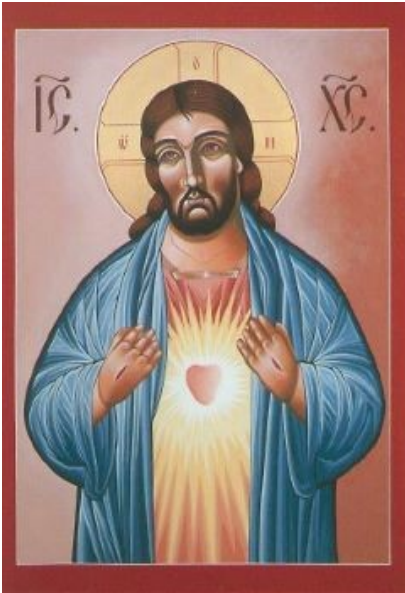

Children's Collection: We have restarted the Children's Collection at all the weekend Masses. One child brings the collection bucket to the front of the church, and other children come forward to put their offering in the bucket.

We hope to raise enough funds to provide housing and stock it with at least two animals. \$80 will purchase a sheep, \$300 a cow, \$450 will provide transitional shelter for a family. All money will go to families in developing countries through Catholic Relief Services.

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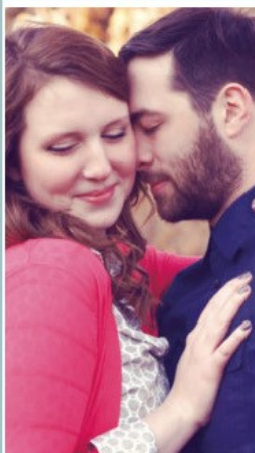
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
