Lent is the 40-day season of penance in preparation for Easter. During this season we pay attention to prayer, **fasting, and giving** – of our time, talent, and treasure. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting (ages 18 - 59) and abstinence from meat (age 14 & older) for Catholics. Also, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat (age 14 & older). When fasting, a person may eat one full meal, and two smaller meals that together do not equal a full meal, and may not eat between meals. Serious circumstances (sickness, dietary needs, social obligation) excuse from fasting & abstinence, but not from other forms of penance. Fr. Steve recommends celebrating Valentine's Day on Tuesday, February 13, this year.

CRS Rice Bowl, our Lenten Food Drive, Book Study, and Prayer, Bread and Soup are good ways to practice prayer, fasting and giving during Lent.


