



Guatemala Mission News: The Guatemala Commission of the Catholic Diocese of Spokane thanks all of you who sent donations for the Guatemala Mission. Your donations are greatly appreciated and essential for mission work to continue.

Donations from the Sacred Heart Church have been directed to the radio station, Nawal Estereo, in Nahualá. Director Lourdes Tzoc Ramirez regularly sends reports and photos of the radio staff broadcasting. The six staff members continue to broadcast eighteen hours each day of the week covering topics such as youth and women issues, religious and political events, and health news. They are very thankful for the new transmitter, purchased last year from donated funds.
