

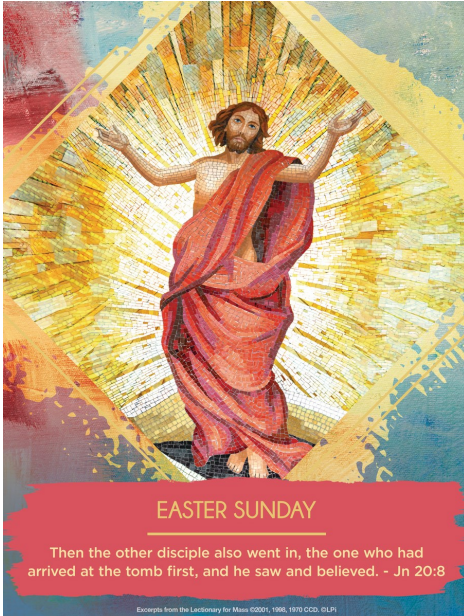

A pair of pigs for a family costs \$60. How many families can we help?

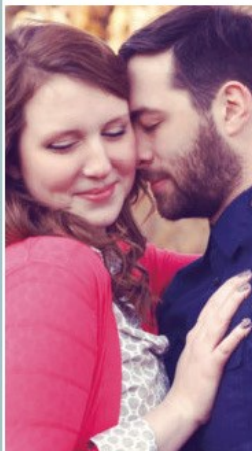
