The Family Room is also convenient for those who need to use the *accessible church entrance* which is behind the altar. This entrance is reached by turning right off Maple St. into the alley behind the church.

There is a bathroom on the main floor of the church in the Holy Family classroom behind the Family Room.

Diaper changing stations are in the upstairs bathroom and men and women's bathrooms (downstairs).

Faith Formation classrooms are downstairs.

A parish library, bulletin board, and Faith Formation offices are located past the downstairs bathrooms, with the social hall at the far end of the building.

The Parish Office (Fr. Steve, office manager, & bulletin editor) is in the old house next to the social hall.

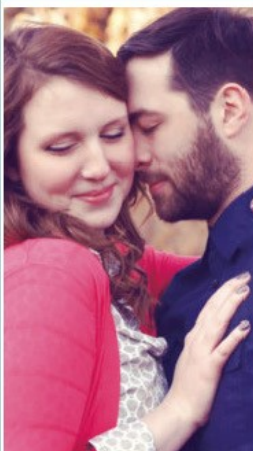
