

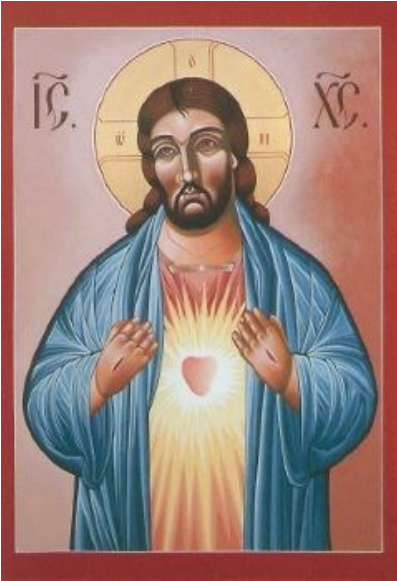

Preparation consists of at-home family instruction and monthly family meetings with lunch.

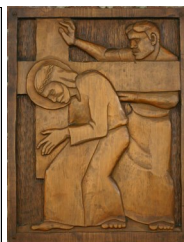

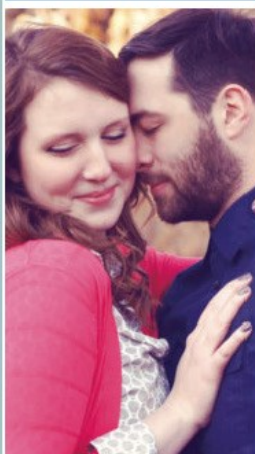
