Caritas Committee Report: This committee researches charities and decides which ones will receive money from the parish. The parish budget includes a varying percentage of its income to give away.

At its November meeting, the Caritas committee agreed to the following donations:

\$1,000 to Catholic Relief Services, Sudan hunger relief. \$1,000 to LEF, an orphanage in Bangladesh.

\$1,000 to Pullman Community Action Center for hotel rooms for temporary housing for the homeless.

\$500 for the needs of Pullman school kids.

\$200 for the Go Fund Me account for Zion Bischoff who died in a traffic accident in November north of Rosalia.

Your kindness will help us continue the work of our Dhaka school, which was so dear to the late Rev. Fr. Thomas MacDermott CSC. In addition, I will be purchasing food for our children, so they can take it home to their villages to share with their single mothers in celebration of Christmas.

This year, our plan is to send most of the children back to their home villages, allowing them to reconnect with the places where they spent the early years of their lives. Some children, however, have no place to return to, so they will stay at LEF, while a few of them will be welcomed into the homes of peers to experience a different atmosphere and celebrate Christmas with new families.

We will of course, cover the cost of their food during their time away from the center.

Thank you again for your ongoing support. Please know that you are always in our thoughts and prayers. We ask that you continue to pray for us and the work of LEF.
