

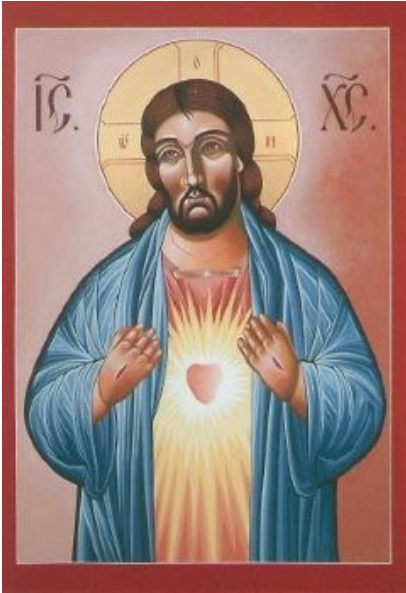

All parish adults are invited to come and learn about the Jubilee Year and discuss how to find hope, with Fr. Steve and other parishioners.

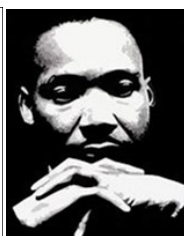

**The Men's Prayer Group** invites Catholic men to join us in the social hall at 7:15 am any Saturday. NOT Jan. 18.

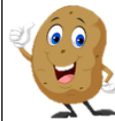

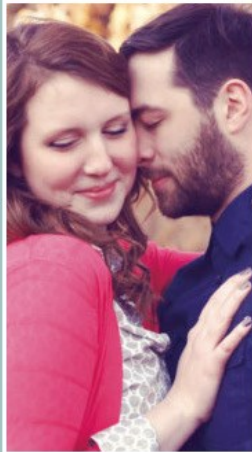
