

Guatemala Mission News
The Guatemala Commission received a
report from Lourdes Tzoc Ramirez,
director of the radio station Nawal Estereo
in Nahualá. The six person radio staff
continues to broadcast 18 hours each day of
the week, both remotely and in the radio

station on a range of topics with many interviews and live broadcasts. They remodeled one of the broadcasting booths. They also completed adding a third floor to the radio station – a project funded by a generous donation. What was just going to be a roof to protect from the rain turned out to be a complete full floor, which they are using as a place for the community to meet and host various functions. They are delighted to be able to complete these projects!
