



Lent is the 40-day season of penance in preparation for Easter. During this season we pay attention to prayer, fasting, and giving – of our time, talent, and treasure.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting (ages 18 – 59) and abstinence from meat (age 14 & older) for Catholics. Also, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat (age 14 & older). When fasting, a person may eat one full meal, and two smaller meals that together do not equal a full meal, and may not eat between meals. Serious circumstances (sickness, dietary needs, social obligation) excuse from fasting & abstinence, but not from other forms of penance. CRS Rice Bowl, our Lenten Food Drive, and Prayer, Bread and Soup are good ways to practice prayer, fasting and giving during Lent.
