

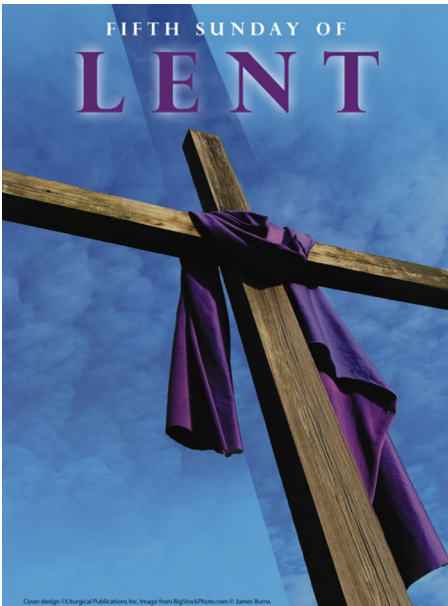

The Diocesan Chrism Mass 2025 is Tuesday, April 8, 5:30 to 7:00 pm, at the Cathedral of Our Lady of Lourdes, 1115 West Riverside Avenue, Spokane. This is a very special Mass, where the Bishop concelebrates with Priests from various regions of the diocese and consecrates the sacred Chrism and blesses the other oils. The sacred Chrism is used to anoint the newly baptized and sign those to be confirmed. The Oil of Catechumens is used to prepare catechumens for Baptism. The Oil of the Sick is used to comfort those who are ill.

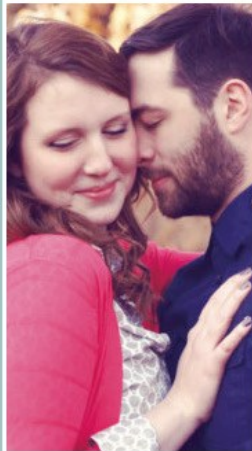

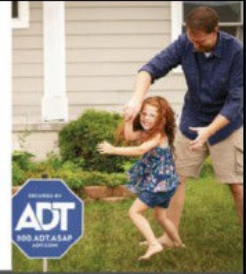
