A warm welcome to all new parishioners. Please register online Welcome using the QR code, or use one of the paper forms at the church entrances.



Parish information: There is a Family Room (an option for families with babies or restless preschoolers) up at the front of the church to the right of the altar.

The Family Room is also convenient for those who need to use the accessible church entrance which is behind the altar. This entrance is reached by turning right off Maple St. into the alley behind the church.

There is a bathroom on the main floor of the church in the Holy Family classroom behind the Family Room.

Faith Formation classrooms are downstairs.

Diaper changing stations are in the upstairs bathroom and men and women's bathrooms (downstairs).

There is a parish library and bulletin board past the downstairs bathrooms, then the social hall at the far end.

The Parish Office (Fr. Steve, and all other staff) is in the old house next to the social hall.



Recycling at Sacred Heart: We take stretchy plastic (We have three collection bins: one at the bottom of the stairs that lead to the classroom hallway, one next to the men's

bathroom, and one at the social hall entrance.), toner/ink cartridges and single-use alkaline and lithium-ion batteries (The cartridge collection box and a batterycollection box are in the parish library. There are more battery boxes on the plastic-recycling boxes). To recycle many electronics, markers, etc., you can take them to Staples. Some items earn store credit, which you can use, or donate to the church by crediting it to Sacred *Heart.* Use the QR code to go to Staples' website for the full list of what they will accept for recycling.

Parish parking permits: If you are new to the parish or if your sticker is faded, we have (removable) parking stickers in the social hall. You need one on your windshield if you park at church any time other than weekend Masses. Parishioners who work or take class nearby may park in our lot weekdays.


