



They offer family shelter, homelessness prevention, stabilization, interim housing, family support services, and items for setting up a home. Right now they need: Diapers (sizes 4&5), Pull-Ups (sizes 3T/4T/5T), baby wipes, paper towels, toilet paper, dish soap & sponges. The Community Action Center Food Bank needs: canned vegetables (beans, peas, carrots, etc.), canned fruit (they have applesauce), pasta sauce, side dishes (mac n cheese, pasta-roni, rice-a-roni, mashed potatoes, etc.) canned meat (they have tuna) and baby wipes. Please place your donations in the marked basket at the church entrance. Thank you!
