

#### Children's Faith Formation

It's time to sign up for Faith Formation! Sunday morning Faith Formation begins Sept. 21. There are NO 8:30 am sessions this year.

#### All sessions are downstairs from 9:45-10:45 am.

This year we have three groups: ages 3-6/Pre-K & K, ages 6-9/grades 1-3, and ages 9-12/grades 4-6. The Faith Formation fee covers materials, but is open to all children regardless of payment.

If you want your child to prepare to receive First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation, you must register SEPARATELY by using the QR code at left.

Children must be 7 years old before Easter and already baptized to receive these sacraments. The first Sacrament Prep meeting is Sunday, Sept. 14, 12 pm, social hall.
