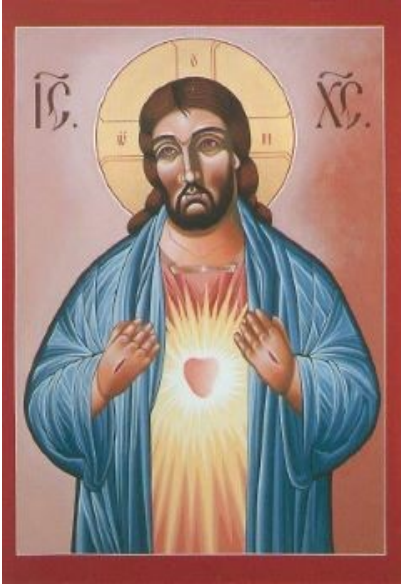

It's time to sign up for Faith Formation!

Sunday morning Faith Formation begins Sept. 21.


There are NO 8:30 am sessions this year.

All sessions are downstairs from 9:45-10:45 am.


This year we have three groups: ages 3-6/Pre-K & K, ages 6-9/grades 1-3, and ages 9-12/grades 4-6.

The Faith Formation fee covers materials, but is open to all children regardless of payment.

 **If you want your child to prepare to receive First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation, you must register SEPARATELY by using the QR code at left.**

Children must be 7 years old before Easter and already baptized to receive these sacraments. *The first Sacrament Prep meeting is Sunday, Sept. 14, 12 pm, social hall.*

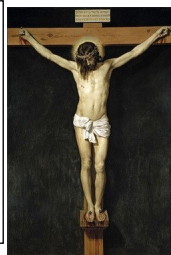

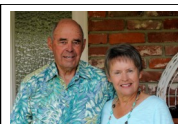

Pat spent 35 years working as editor of Washington State University's alumni publications. He died in March. Laurie worked for 19 years as a music teacher at Franklin Elementary and has led Sacred Heart Church's choir for 45 years.

Thank you for your gift of \$1,030 to Doctors Without Borders, and for joining a global movement providing lifesaving humanitarian project on the ground and speaking out about what we see.

Your support allows us to remain independent impartial, and neutral—allowing our teams to respond quickly when emergencies strike. Our work relies on kindhearted individuals like you.

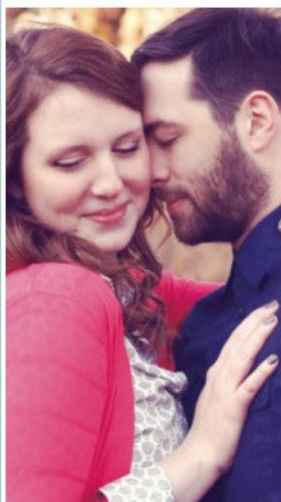

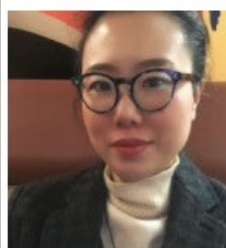
