

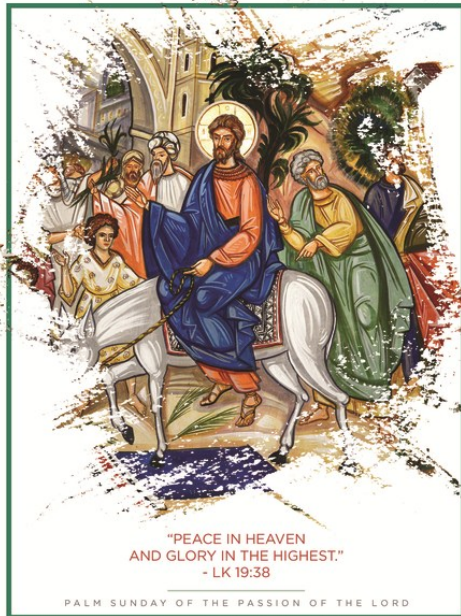

## Holy Week Notes

*Incense will be used at the end of the Holy Thursday Mass, and at the beginning of the Easter Vigil.*

**Wednesday:** Tenebrae Service at 7 pm. The Evening Prayer is said while candles are extinguished one by one. The last one is hidden, symbolizing Jesus' burial.

**Holy Thursday:** No morning Mass. All are encouraged to pray before the Blessed Sacrament after Mass at the Altar of Repose. It will be in the social hall until 10 pm.

**Good Friday:** No morning Mass. The Good Friday Service for children is from 6:30 to 7 pm with readings and veneration of the Cross. Everyone is welcome.

**Holy Saturday:** No confessions and no 4:30 pm Mass.

**Headphones** - if you have trouble hearing the Mass, we have four FM radio headsets that pick up the signal we broadcast. You can take one from the rack at the back of the church, and return it when you leave.

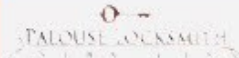

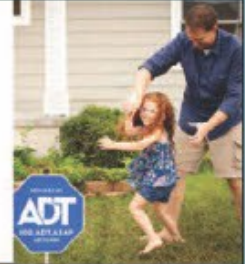
