- NO PHONES**
Turn your mobile phones off.
- PARTICIPATE**
Sing, respond, listen, and pray.
- GENUFLECT**
Kneel your right knee in the direction of the tabernacle before sitting.
- PARTICIPATE**
Sing, respond, listen, and pray.
- COMMUNE**
Examine conscience beforehand.
- THINK OF OTHERS**
Respect the pews and queue.
- BE STILL**
Don't be in a hurry. Enjoy and feel God's presence and thank Him for His graces.
