

Because the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception has been moved to Monday, December 9<sup>th</sup>, and declared as a Holy Day of Obligation in the United States, we are presented with the following scenario to meet both our Sunday obligation and Holy Day Obligation, as required by the Church...

## **Sunday Obligation**

The Sunday December 8<sup>th</sup> 5:00pm Mass <u>will be a Vigil Mass</u> for the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, however, it <u>cannot</u> be counted for <u>both</u> the Sunday Obligation and Holy Day Obligation. If one attends the Sunday 5:00pm Mass to meet their Sunday Obligation, one would still need to attend Mass on Monday to meet the Holy Day Obligation.






