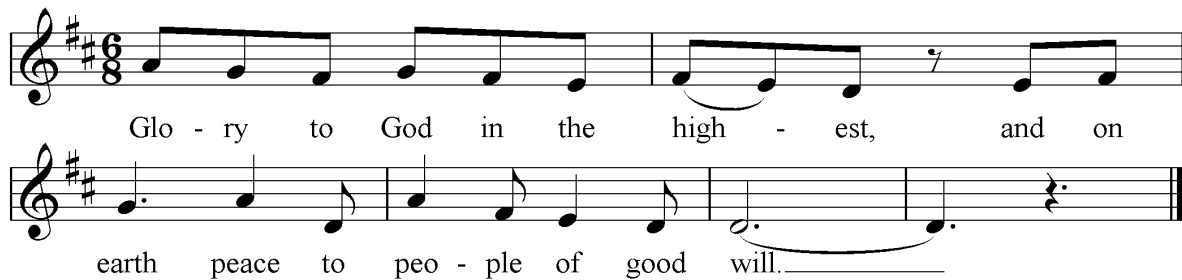

in the glory of God the Father. Amen. *(Refrain)*

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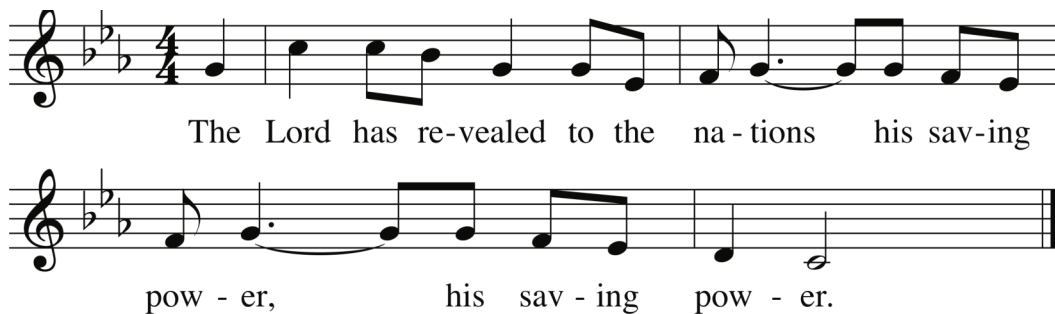
