CHILDREN'S CORNER



Children's Faith Formation . . . Not just for First Holy Communion and Confirmation!

G.I.F.T (Growing in Faith Together) is our Religious Education program for children in grades PreK(4)-8 in Public School. Children learn their Catholic Faith Traditions, parts of the Catholic Mass, and develop a deeper relationship with Jesus through Christ through prayer and Mass.

Registration is now open online.

Children attending G.I.F.T. are eligible to play sports for Saint Mary Academy.

Cost is \$75 per child. Classes are on **Sundays from 9:45am-10:45am, beginning on September 7** and follow the school calendar.



First Holy Communion: usually received in the 2nd grade. Preparation is a two-year program, usually beginning in 1st grade.

Confirmation: usually received in the 8th grade. Preparation is a two-year program, usually beginning in 7th grade.
