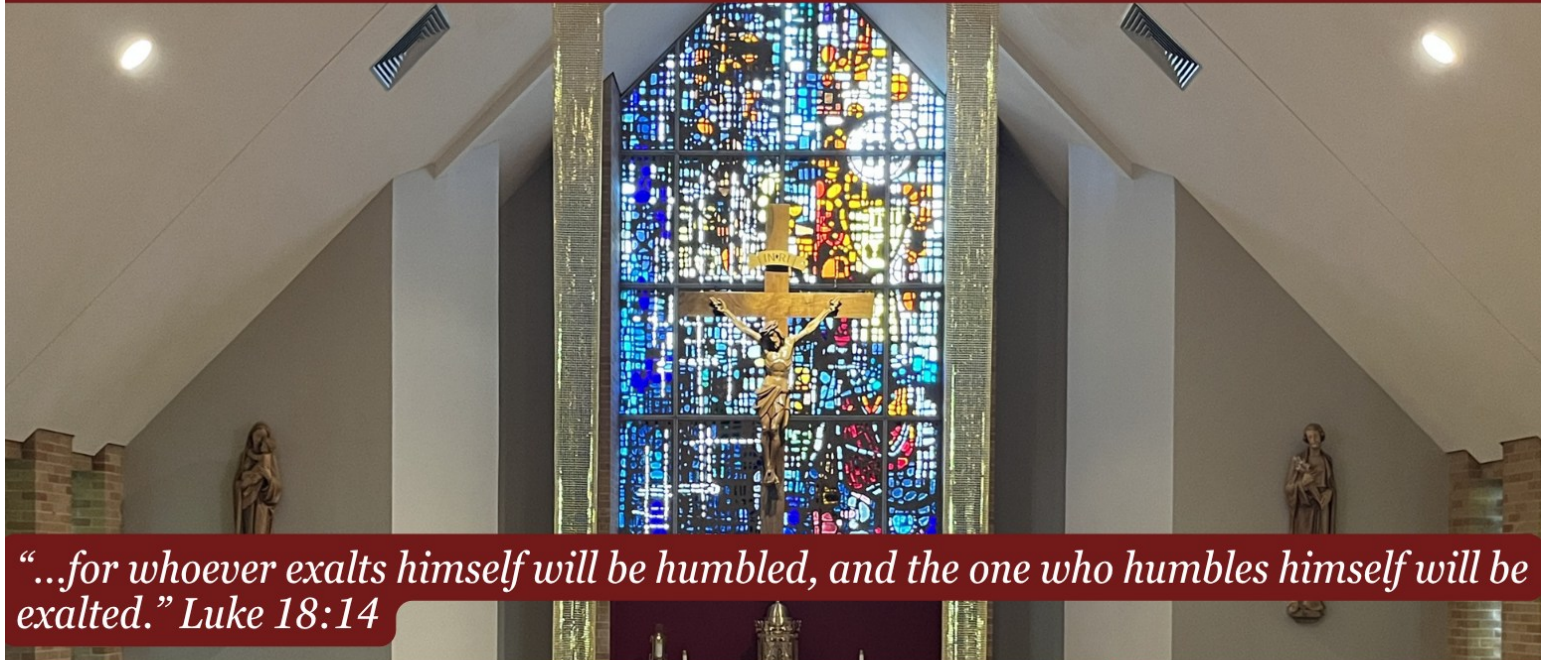

What is a Plenary Indulgence?

A plenary indulgence is a grace granted by the Church that removes all temporal punishment due to sins that have already been forgiven in Confession. The Church offers the plenary indulgence as an extraordinary gift of mercy to all pilgrims, helping them reflect on God's infinite forgiveness.

Receiving a Plenary Indulgence

The conditions necessary for a Jubilee indulgence include:

1. Being in a state of grace and disposed to receive the indulgence
2. Having confessed one's sins sacramentally
3. Receiving Holy Communion
4. Offer prayers for the Holy Father and his intentions
5. If able, make a pilgrimage to a designated Jubilee pilgrim site, such as Houston's Co-Cathedral of the Sacred Heart or St. Mary Cathedral Basilica in Galveston
