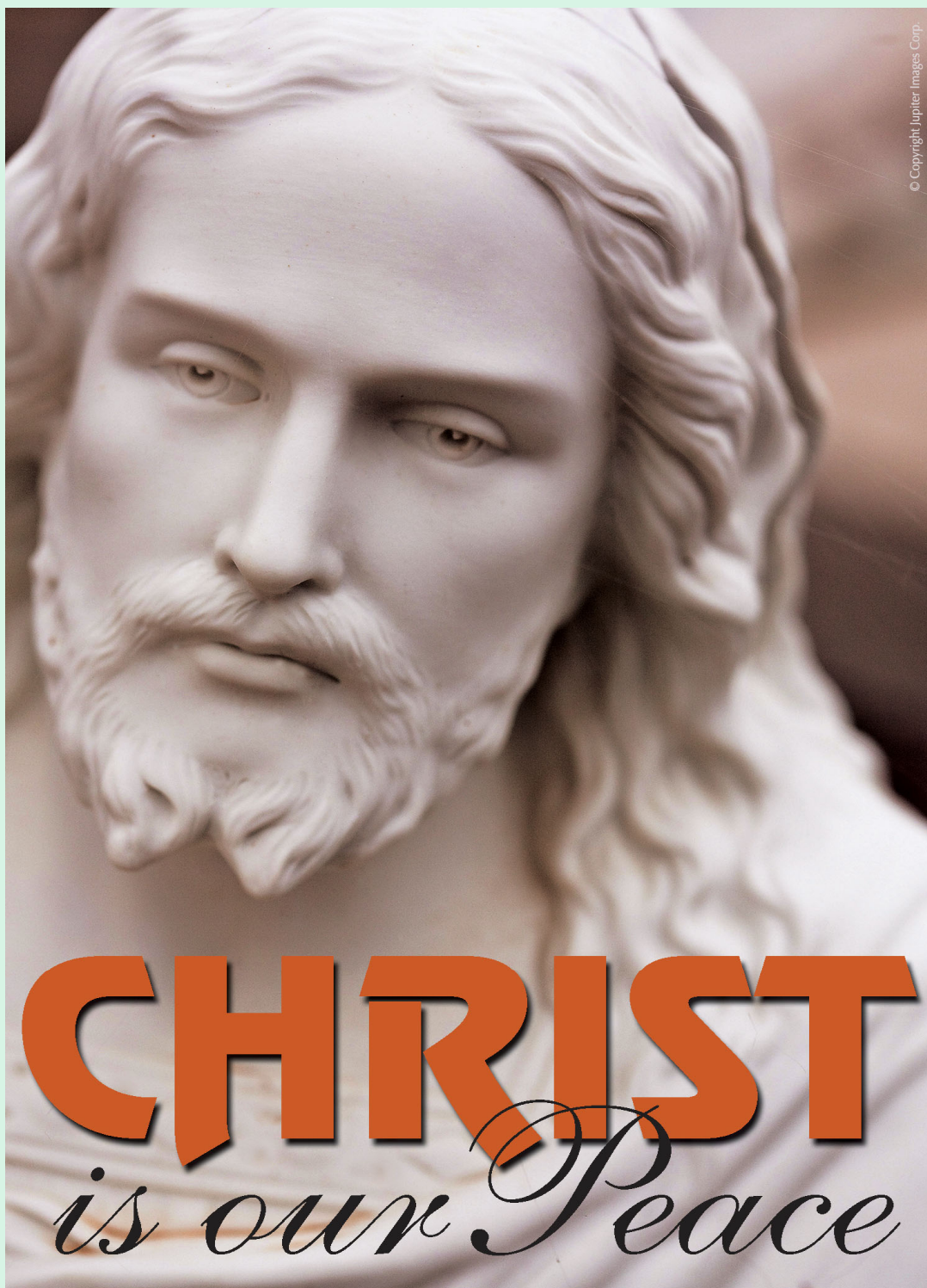

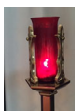

REGISTRATION

Registration for catechism classes will be held every Monday and Tuesday evenings from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. during August, 2021. There will be no registration on August 17th.

All public school students in grades 1—11 must register each year. Parents of first-time students must bring a copy of their child's baptismal certificate to register.

All Catholic high school students in grades 9-11 must register with the CCD Office for the High School Religion program in order to prepare for the sacrament of Confirmation.
