I will always remember him as a priest loving everyone without any distinction, and going the extra mile to help anyone in need, whether spiritual or emotional. He truly exemplifies Pope Francis' encouragement to all priests to "smell like sheep". He has been instrumental helping our parish to grow in faith, hope and love! He will be much missed!!!

May we all keep Fr. Lopez in our prayers! May God continue to bless Fr. Lopez and his entire family! May God give him many, many more years of priestly ministry.
