From the Desk of Fr. Joe Zabinski

Parishioners of St Albert!

We have had a wonderful week this past week celebrating our patronal feast day! In case you missed it - we began with food for the soul - with a beautiful Mass, the Eucharist, and the relic of St Albert. We then had an awesome meal on Sunday after the 10:00am Mass which we had an accordion player there, ability for pics on a German street, lots of prizes drawings, and one of my favorite things - the Vikings game! I felt like I was in Germany - of course not including the Vikings game! Thank you to Tom Berning and the Parish Council for helping to organize this. It was a wonderful experience!

This weekend at all the Masses we have a message from the Archbishop regarding implementing the Archdiocesan Synod from Pentecost Weekend in June. The Archbishop has made this a very high priority for our Archdiocese and so for our parishes. As a part of this, a video from the Archbishop will be played during the homily at all the weekend Masses. Please strive to make it to Mass this weekend! It is very important for our Archbishop whom we have as our head shepherd in the Archdiocese.

There are a couple of things happening with this at the parish level. Here at St Albert, we'll have the Archbishop's video and this article on our parish website and on our Facebook page - in case you do not see it or want to see it again. The Archbishop has also asked the Pastors of parishes to pray about a team of people to help implement the synod, called the Synod Evangelization Team (SET). This team will be composed of some of our staff members; it will also be composed of other parishioners in our parish. Let's keep our Archbishop, our Archdiocese, and our parish in our prayers.

Lastly, this past July, we implemented new daily Mass times. I wanted to go through the rationale for this change in Mass times. Because the survey responses were pretty equal, there was no clear route one way or the other as to the most desired Mass time for daily Masses here at St. Albert. Because of this, I discussed the matter with our parish trustees, the parish council, the staff, and our parish leadership team (PLT).

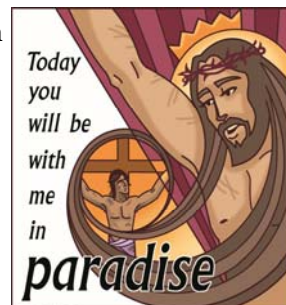
A couple of things we looked at regarding Mass times. The first is continuity and the second is diversity. First, continuity. In the past here, we have had Mass at 8:00am. This seemed to be a good time to have. The majority of the people at the weekday Masses were ok with having Mass at 8:00am. Another reason with continuity is that 8:00am Mass is now offered here from Tuesday to Thursday, with Friday being the same time we had in the past for 1st Friday Masses - Masses at noon.

The second main reason was for diversity. We wanted to find a Mass time that allows as many people as possible to make it to daily Mass in our area. If 7:30am was too early, then they would have an 8:00am option. Also, within the area churches, there are not many options for Tuesday morning Mass. St Michael, St John the Baptist in Dayton, Our Lady Queen of Peace, and St. Henry have no daily Mass on Tuesday mornings. Next, with diversity we wanted to provide a Mass for those who wanted to come to Mass on Friday during a lunch break. This is why we provide Mass at Noon on Friday with Confessions afterwards.

Lastly, let's be grateful for what we have from the Lord. I know there is a few people who are disappointed at having the Mass time changed. We are ... **Continued on Page VI**

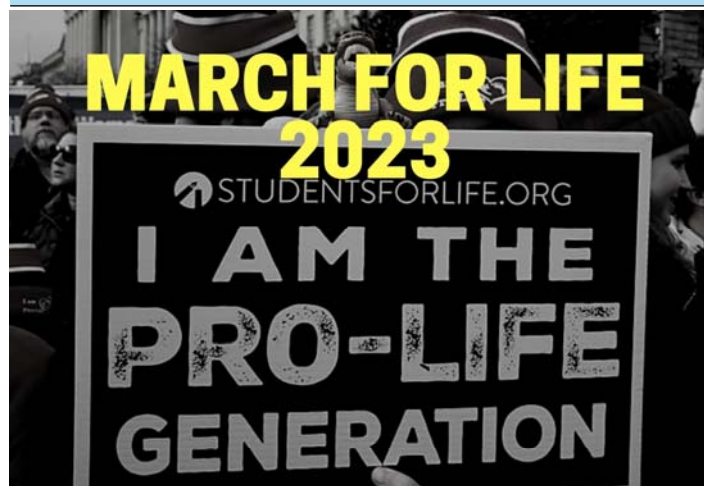
