From the Desk of Fr. Joe Zabinski



Parishioners of St Albert! Happy Easter! Jesus is Risen! He is truly Risen!

In and through all the suffering of His passion and cruel death on the cross, He rose to life again! This shows us in a real, physical way that He is more powerful than the worst thing in life - namely physical death to our bodies and spiritual death to our souls by way of sin. This can give us great hope! I would encourage you all to make this Sunday, not a day about Easter bunnies and Easter egg hunts, but a

day about the fact that Jesus has conquered all of our worst fears - namely death and hell. I hope with this celebration that you'll be able to ponder with your families this reality - that nothing - no cross in this life - is without merit. We may be experiencing a place in our lives that perhaps even feels like a Nazi training camp but we can still be people with joy and hope in the fact that Jesus Christ has conquered even that kind of suffering. Sufferings, death and sin have no match against God and the power of His love for us!

Living our lives for Christ may entail more suffering than we would if we weren't living our life in such a way, but because this day of the Resurrection, we can be people who find meaning in suffering. We can be people who find hope in suffering like that; we can be people who find even joy in suffering like that. This is the beauty of this great feast day of our Church! This is the beauty of the gift of what Christ did for us this day of the Resurrection! I hope that all of you will be able to ponder this reality this day and keep this reality in our hearts from this day forward. It will be a great source of hope and a great source of joy because we are Christians!

April 9 is the feast day of Saint Casilda. Casilda was the daughter of a Muslim leader in Toldeo, Spain, and lived during the 10th century. She was raised a Muslim and showed special kindness to Christian prisoners. When she was a young woman, she became quite ill and was convinced that the local doctors could not cure her. Instead, Casilda made a pilgrimage to the shrine of San Vicenzo in northern Spain. She was cured, and then became a Christian. After becoming a Christian, Casilda lived the rest of her life as a hermit not far from the shrine, and died when about 100 years old. She died in the year 1050. ~ St. Casilda, Pray for us!

At the Easter Vigil, the Exsultet is sung as Mass begins in darkness, illuminated only by candles throughout the church. The Exsultet is a beautiful hymn of rejoicing in Christ's triumph over sin and death. One part states:

O truly necessary sin of Adam, destroyed completely by the Death of Christ!

O happy fault that earned for us so great, so glorious a Redeemer!

This line stands out because it calls the sin of Adam "necessary" and refers to it as "O happy fault." At first, this might seem strange. Why is it that we refer to the sin of Adam, Original Sin, as "necessary" and "happy?" The answer is Easter. It's because God, in His perfect wisdom and love, took sin and the consequence of sin (death) and used them as the means of the salvation of the world. That's what Easter is all about!


