

### From the Desk of Fr. Joe Zabinski

#### **Hello Parishioners of St Albert!**

I hope that your Advent Season is off to a great start! Over this past month there has been a lot of good things taking place here in the parish! First of all - we had our St. Albert Feast Day Celebration which was a great turn out! Thank you to all of you who came out for it! Thank you also to the Parish Council who led the endeavor - organizing it and finding people to volunteer for it. Good work!

Secondly, we've started off our 2nd round of RCIA here at St. Alberts. Thank you to Jean Wold and our Catechists who are helping to lead our weekly sessions. We just had the Rite of Welcome for our three Candidates. The Rite of Welcome



is an official way of acknowledging those who are Baptized, but not yet Catholic as official Candidates for receiving Confirmation and 1st Holy Eucharist at the Easter Vigil this coming Easter. If you know anyone who would like to become Catholic, it is not too late to start the journey of RCIA. Please send me an email if anyone is interested. I'm still praying for more Sacraments here at St Alberts especially the Sacrament of Matrimony.

Speaking of Sacraments being received, these past two months, we have had the most Baptisms that we've seen here at St. Alberts within that period of time - at least that I've seen within my time here at St. Alberts! We had multiple Baptisms per a month and multiple people getting Baptized each time. It is great to see as the shepherd of this parish! During that time, I also experienced a milestone as a priest. I experienced my first 5 Sacrament day! I celebrated a Wedding Mass, baptized two children, administered the Anointing of the Sick, heard Confessions, and celebrated multiple Masses that day!

Within the past couple months, the Master Planning Team was able to solicit feedback on the potential building project. We are now moving into the next phase of planning which is the Fundraising Viability Analysis phase, mentioned in the "Communication Corner" in last week's bulletin.

This past Sunday, I talked about the devastating "Pew Survey" fact that 69% of Catholics do not believe in the presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. This is very sad! out Bishop Barron's book and are now focusing on that book within formation for the Parish Council, Staff, Liturgical Committee, and Finance Council. We just handed this book out to the parish this past weekend at the Sunday Masses. I am amazed - we bought 400 copies of this book and they are all gone! What an amazing response by you the parishioners! As a part of handing out that book, we gave a bookmark which had a schedule on it to help read it by Christmas.

This past Sunday, in my homily, I also mentioned that my homily series this Advent season will be focused on the Eucharist. On the first Sunday of Advent, I focused on the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. On this second Sunday of Advent, Deacon is preaching about Eucharistic Adoration and making a push for additional adorers. With Adoration, my goal is to have a healthy substitute list and to eventually expand the hours to have adoration end by 3:00pm on Saturday and begin by Noon on Sunday. We hope to eventually accomplish that, but we'll focus on what we have thus far - making sure we have time slots filled and a healthy substitute list. On the 3rd Sunday of Advent, my homily will focus on how to receive the Eucharist reverently and fruitfully in a practical kind of way. Then finally for the fourth Sunday of Advent, I'll talk about the Eucharistic miracles and have some display boards available about various miracles throughout the world. I'm excited about this homily series and I hope that you can tune into it!

Please Note: Because Christmas lands on a Monday this year, there's no two for one! To fulfill the Sunday and Christmas obligations, one needs to go to one weekend Mass for the Sunday obligation and one Christmas Mass (Christmas Eve or Day) for the Christmas obligation. The schedule can be found on our website and in this week's bulletin.

As you can see - there are many good and beautiful things happening for the Lord at St. Alberts! Let's continue to pray for the parish, the staff, myself and our parish leaders. Thank you!


