LENT AND BAPTISM

We are all familiar with repentance as the prominent theme of Lent - ashes, conversion, confession. But an equally prominent theme for Lent is baptism. "Lent is marked by two themes: the baptismal and the penitential. By recalling or preparing for baptism and by repentance, the season disposes the faithful ... to celebrate the paschal mystery." (Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, #109) Baptism is a death to our old way of life - a death united to the death of Christ and therefore a rising to new life in Christ. And so early on, the Church decided to celebrate baptism with new Christians at Easter when we also celebrate the paschal mystery of Christ's death and resurrection. Lent, then, became the time to focus on final preparation for baptism for those coming into the Church and for the faithful to remember their own baptism. Baptism itself is about conversion, about newness of life, about Christ transforming us with the power of his Spirit. How can you think about your own baptism during this season of Lent? What do you need to let go of in order to be renewed this Easter?
