## — Pastor's Corner | Rex Rund, Director of Liturgy &amp; Music

**Save the Date!**

This weekend we rejoice with the whole church and with OLMC's Hartman family at the Ordination to the Priesthood of Father Nicholas Hartman, O.P. Fr. Nicholas's ordination with the Dominican Order is May 20 in Washington, D.C., and he will celebrate a ***Mass of Thanksgiving at OLMC on Sunday, May 28 at the 12:30 PM Mass***, with a reception following in the narthex. It is always a blessed day when a son of the parish celebrates Mass, so please come join in prayer and thanksgiving!

Father Nicholas was born on December 8, 1992, to Chris and Kathleen Hartman in Charlotte, North Carolina. Soon afterward, his family moved to Carmel, where they attended Our Lady of Mount Carmel Parish and where Nicholas and his five siblings grew up attending OLMC School and Guerin Catholic High School. It was at OLMC where he received his Catholic education and grew up in the faith — receiving his First Communion and, later, Confirmation; learning about his faith and how to pray, as well as serving Mass. At OLMC, he first discerned a vocation to the priesthood when preparing for his First Communion, which was nourished by his family and by priests, seminarians, and fellow parishioners. It was on a retreat during his freshman year at Guerin Catholic that he began discerning religious life, looking specifically to the Dominicans by the end of his senior year.

After graduating from OLMC in 2007 and Guerin Catholic in 2011, he studied philosophy at Indiana University from 2011 to 2015 and spent a year in graduate studies in philosophy at the Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas in Rome. On August 8, 2016, the Feast of St. Dominic, he entered the novitiate for the Order of Preachers (the Dominicans) at St. Gertrude Priory in Cincinnati, Ohio. He professed simple vows as a Dominican friar on August 15, 2017, and then began his studies for the priesthood at the Dominican House of Studies in Washington, D.C. During that time, he had ministries in a hospice, RCIA, doing editorial work for MAGNIFICAT, leading theology discussions for the Thomistic Institute, and helping out with Howard University's campus ministry.

While in Washington, he professed solemn vows in the Order on February 5, 2022, and was ordained a deacon a month later. After finishing his theological studies, he was ordained to the priesthood on May 20, 2023, at the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C. His first assignment as a Dominican priest, beginning on June 20, will be at St. Thomas Aquinas University Parish in Charlottesville, Virginia, a parish that also serves the University of Virginia community. Fr. Nicholas will serve there as a parochial vicar, having previously spent his summer as a deacon at the same parish in 2022.

St. Dominic de Guzmán founded the Order of Preachers in 1216 to be an Order of consecrated religious priests devoted to the intellectual and contemplative life, lived out in a community, who would then turn and pour out the graces they received in that contemplative life through their preaching. It was St. Dominic's mission for the Order that initially drew Fr. Nicholas to the Dominicans.

For a Dominican priest searches to know Jesus Christ in loving friendship through the inner life of study and contemplation and seeks to give to others the fruits of that life through his priestly acts of preaching and the sacraments.

Fr. Nicholas is grateful for all he received at OLMC. Please pray for him as he begins his priestly ministry.

## •• ASK THE APOLOGIST ••with Steven O'Keefe•••••

**Dear Apologist,**


**I was told that the ascension accounts of Acts and Luke contradict. Do they?**

The Gospel of Luke and Acts both give accounts of the ascension of our Lord. Some believe the two accounts contradict one another. The first thing to remember is that they were both written by Luke, so it would seem strange for Luke to contradict himself. Acts 1:3-11 says Jesus joined His apostles for forty days, told them to stay in Jerusalem until Pentecost, and took them to Bethany where He ascended. Luke 24:36-51 says Jesus met his apostles, told them to stay in Jerusalem, and immediately took them out to Bethany where He ascended. There is no mention of the 40 days.

Something like this also happens between Acts 9:25 and Acts 9:26. It says Paul escaped Damascus and went to Jerusalem. But in Galatians 1:15-18 we read that after Paul escaped from Damascus he went to Arabia, returned to Damascus for 3 years, and then finally traveled to Jerusalem. If you just read the text of Acts 9:25-26, you'd think there was nothing in between Paul's escape from Damascus and his return to Jerusalem. Paul's letter reveals there is a whole 3 years between those two verses.

The Biblical writers didn't feel the need to include every detail and every length of time. They allowed themselves to compress the events they describe for the sake of space and simplicity. In this case, Luke was likely facing a very practical concern. Namely, he was running out of space on his scroll and decided to condense the events of the ascension, knowing he would elaborate in his second volume. Luke knew the events of the resurrection were stretched out over forty days and was not trying to assert otherwise when he concluded his gospel. So, there is no contradiction.

## How to Report an Incident of Sexual Abuse of a Minor

If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse in the past or present day by clergy (priest or deacon) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

1. Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800.800.5556 or local law enforcement.
2. Call Jackie Montrie M.A., LMFT, LMHC, Victim Assistance Coordinator of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana at 765.464.4988.
3. Thereafter, an investigation will be undertaken by or on behalf of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana.

If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse in the past or present day by someone working in a parish or school for the Roman Catholic Church in the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana (such as a religious sister or brother, lay employee, lay volunteer, etc.), you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

1. Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800.800.5556 or local law enforcement.
2. Call our Ethics Hotline 855.375.6796, or go to [dioceseoflafayetteinindiana.ethicspoint.com](http://dioceseoflafayetteinindiana.ethicspoint.com).
