

FROM FR. LEO



Naaman is cured by Elisha, the man of God. Naaman is so grateful that his flesh has become like that of a little child with no trace of his deadly leprosy. Out of gratitude he wants to gift Elisha, but Elisha recognizing the work as God's and not his own, refuses the gift. A sign of Elisha's genuineness.

The best Naaman can do is take some of the soil so he can sacrifice to the only true God of Israel. Gratitude and humility are the spiritual gifts witnessed in this passage. Naaman grateful and Elisha humble.

The gospel builds on this theme. Ten Lepers are cured by Jesus but only one comes back to give thanks. What is interesting is that the one who comes back is a Samaritan, someone not obliged to Mosaic law as the other nine.

Yet it is he who shows gratitude to Jesus out of his genuine gratefulness. The others did the legal requirement to see the priest who would declare them clean so they could enter society again. What a blessing! But it is the one who, not bound by the legalism of religion, comes back and expresses his profound gratitude.

These two passages from scripture remind us how important humility and gratitude are in a genuine Christian life. The two go together. You can't have one without the other. It is the Spirit that effects this in us. Elisha knew God was the healer and the Samaritan knew genuine gratefulness from the heart.

This week, let us keep these men in our thoughts. Let us practice humility and gratefulness. It is then we will experience the joy that comes when Christ lives in us, and his ways become our ways.




STILL A CHANCE TO SIGN UP! CHILDREN'S CHOIR HAS BEGUN!
