

FROM FR. LEO



The story we hear in Luke's gospel reminds us to be persistent in our prayer.

There are two ways we can look at that. One is that persistence in prayer will eventually bring the justice we pray for. For when we pray for what is God's will, God will answer. Sometimes it is a long time in coming and it is then we may feel abandoned. But your trust in God will bear fruit one way or another.

I think of the twenty hostages that were just released in Israel. For two years they were in torment and their families as well. It was good to see the faith expressed in those reunions. Their prayers were answered.

But then, what about the many that died and the thousands of innocent victims? Were they unfaithful? I don't believe so. We consider them victims and martyrs which has its own reward.

The second way we can think of being persistent in prayer is simply to show up every day for prayer. Sticking to our daily prayers makes a big difference in how our lives unfold. That daily rosary builds something in us as we experience the Spirit more readily and more often.

You can pray with You Tube too! Sometimes I tune in there and let one of my brothers lead as I pray. The daily office, or divine office of the church is also on line. So everyday an hour spent there is praying as part of the universal church.

Persistence is not just for monks; at some level it is key to our own lives of faith!
