FROM FR. LEO



The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

"Today you will be with me in paradise"

The contrast between the two criminals hanging next to Jesus on the cross strikes me. The one reviled Jesus, and snidely says, "If you're who you say you, are save us." Tough character. Nastiness fills his heart to the end.

Opposite that, we have the thief who rebuked the snide man and called for respect since he knew, unlike them, Jesus was innocent. Then he expresses his faith in Christ as he asked to be taken into his kingdom. Jesus replied that he would be with him that very day in paradise.

Like the parable of Mary and Martha, I think there is some of each criminal in each of us. We are encouraged in this gospel to become like the humble thief. The Indians have an expression that in each of us there is a wolf and a lamb, and we chose daily which one we are going to feed.

The beauty of this story is Christ's mercy for those who are open to the mercy of Jesus. The humble thief paid no debt, but his humility allowed him to be filled with Christ eternally.

For each of us Christ is awaiting our request for his mercy; that we might live in his Spirit now and forever. As long as we come to Jesus and ask for mercy, he will lovingly raise us up more than we could ever dream.

Together in this celebration, we celebrate Christ in us. We receive his mercy in the Eucharist as he continues to help us grow in holiness. So we pay together that we may love Jesus because we feel in our hearts his unconditional love for us.
